MENTORSHIP PROCESS

To begin the mentorship program you must:

- Be a Freshman or Sophomore in an engineering or engineering related program.
- Fill out a mentorship program application that you can find on the Engineering Center website.

- The Engineering Center will then find an engineering mentor that fits the students interest.
- The engineering mentor and student will then coordinate a date to shadow and introduce you to the field of engineering.
- The Engineering Center will reach out to the student once they finish with their mentorship to gauge the success. If another mentorship is in the best interest of the student, the student can continue the mentorship program.

- Electrical Engineering

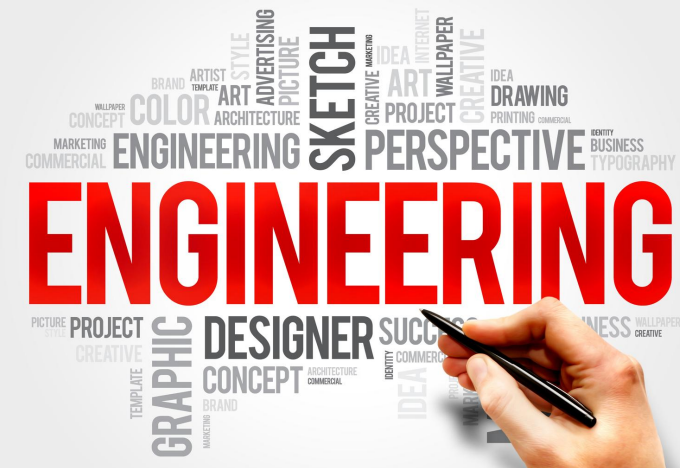
